# Feeding Guide

Feeding the correct amount of Equi-Feeds Balancer for your horse's body weight and workload will ensure that he gets the nutrients he needs because he is getting a fully balanced diet.

Equi-Feeds Balancer is formulated as a concentrate and contains quality protein and amino acids for fertility, reproduction, foetus development, growth, muscle definition and performance, which along with balanced levels of critical macro and micro trace minerals for sound skeletal development and Bio-Mos® and Yea-Sacc for optimum gut health and immune system defences.

Equi-Feeds Balancer can be fed on its own when horses do not require additional grain or used to balance home mixed diets or top up premixed feeds when not used to recommended levels.

Adjust grain intake according to pregnancy and lactation status, age, breed, growth rate, body condition, work load and pasture/hay availability and quality.


If horses are obese, laminitic or suffering from developmental orthopaedic disease remove grain from the diet and feed Equi-Feeds Balancer with chaff and or hay. Seek professional advice.

### **Feeding Tips**

- 1. Introduce Equi-Feeds Balancer to your horse's diet gradually over a 7-14 day period.
- 2. Feed by weight and not by volume.
- 3. Feed a minimum of 1% of your horse's body weight daily as roughage.
- 4. Horses have small stomachs, so feed little and often.
- 5. Ensure horses have access to clean water.
- 6. Do not add additional vitamins or minerals unless directed by a veterinarian or nutritionist.

## **Ingredients**

Equi-Feeds Balancer is a blend of the following quality ingredients:

Soya Bean Meal, Canola Meal, Vegetable Protein Meals, Palm based Fat, Calcium Carbonate, Mono Calcium Phosphate, Magnesium Oxide, Salt, Bio-Mos®, Equi-Feeds Vitamin and Chelated Mineral Premix, Bio-Available Selenium, Lysine, Methionine, Natural Vitamin E, Yea Sacc®1026 (APVMA App. No. 40538) and Biotin.

## **Special Ingredients:**

Bio-Available Selenium – Selenium acts as an antioxidant to prevent fatty acid oxidation which can cause tissue damage. Research has shown that Sel-Plex®, an organic form of selenium, is more readily absorbed and retained than selenium in inorganic forms.

Biotin – Biotin, a water soluble vitamin is required by the enzymes responsible for protein synthesis and as a result is an essential vitamin for the healthy growth of hair and hooves. Research has shown that biotin improves skin and coat condition, increases hoof integrity and is widely recommended by farriers, veterinarians and scientists.

Natural Vitamin E – This unique and highly stable form of Natural Vitamin is more bio available and potent than regular synthetic sources of Vitamin E. Research has shown that Natural Vitamin E provides higher retention levels in plasma further aiding antioxidant, immune, cardiovascular, circulatory, neuromuscular and reproductive functions.

Yea Sacc®1026 – Yea Sacc®1026 is a live yeast culture derived from the specific yeast strain Saccharomyces cerevisiae 1026. The addition of Yea Sacc®1026 to equine diets increases fibre, phosphorus and calcium digestibility in mares, and increases gross energy, total lipids and amino acid absorption. Improves milk availability to foals if administered for 3-4 weeks before and throughout the lactation period.

Palm Based Fat – This contains triglycerides, phospholipids, unsaturated fatty acids and vitamin E as an alternative energy source to carbohydrates.
